BASIS OF AWARD:

The basis of Award of Contract is the lowest Total Amount bid by a responsible Contractor. The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all proposals and to waive any informalities in any proposal or bid. A Bidder's prior history of unsatisfactory performance on work of any kind shall constitute grounds for disqualifying a Bidder.

The undersigned understands the estimate of construction items hereinbefore set forth is approximate only, being given as a basis for the comparison of bids and the Crockett Community Services District does not expressly or by implication agree that the actual amount of work will correspond therewith, but reserves the right to increase or decrease the extent of any item of the work or to omit items of the work as may be deemed necessary or expedient by the District and/or required by funding limitations.

The undersigned understands all bids will be compared on the basis of the District's estimate of the items of the work to be done.

The undersigned has checked carefully all of the above figures and understands that the Crockett Community Services District shall not be responsible for any errors or omissions on the part of the undersigned in making up this bid.

In accordance with Section 4552 of the California Public Contract Code, the bidder agrees that if the bid is accepted, it will assign to the Owner all rights, title and interest in and to all causes of action it may have under Section 4 of the Clayton Act (15 U.S.C. Section 15) or under the Cartwright Act (Chapter 2 (commencing Section 16700) of Part 2 of Division 7 of the California Business and Professions Code), arising from purchase of goods, materials, or services by the bidder for sale to the Owner pursuant to the bid. Such assignment shall be made and become effective at the time the Owner tenders final payment to the bidder.

It is agreed that this bid may not be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) days from the opening thereof.

The terms and conditions of the final contract when executed shall control and supersede anything herein to the contrary or inconsistent with such contract.

Attached is the proposal guaranty bond form bound herewith, duly executed in the amount of at least ten (10) percent of the total amount of our proposal; or alternately there is attached a certified or cashier's check payable to the Owner in the amount of at least ten (10) percent of the amount of our proposal. Folsom Lake Intake Improvements

Location: El Dorado Hills, CA

Project Highlights:

- The Folsom Lake Intake provides a vital water source for customers in El Dorado Hills, particularly during the summer. Royal Electric Company was subcontracted by Granite Construction to assist in improving the reliability of the original 1958 intake. The work involved new structures, pumps, and associated piping, electrical control as well as site modifications. The project also included the construction of a temperature-controlled device to enrich downstream habitat for salmon and trout.
- Royal's scope of work included the installation of trench sheeting shoring and bracing as well as demolition of booster pumps, yard piping, electrical vaults, main switchboard, PG&E transformer and cabling, existing motor control centers and VFD units.
- Royal crews also installed conduit, poured concrete pads, installed electric vaults, medium voltage switch gear, SWGR A/B remote breaker control panels, motor control centers, VFD panels, a transformer and generator termination cabinet.

Sonoma Treatment Plant Electrical Resiliency

Location: Sonoma, CA

Project Highlights:

- This project involved the replacement of electrical switchgear, switchboard, transfer switches and associated electrical equipment to improve electrical resiliency at the Sonoma Valley Wastewater Treatment Plant.
- Due to constant flow of wastewater into the plant, the facility's pumps needed to remain in operation while Royal crews performed the work. The first phase included a change out of the 12KV transformer, requiring a shutdown of the plant and utilization of temporary power.
- The largest phase of the project involved a four-day shutdown with three shifts of crews working around the clock each day. Generators were placed at eight locations throughout the facility while the major 480V switchboard was replaced.
- As most of the plant was shut down, crews followed Royal's safe off, lock out, tag out process. Then existing feeds from the switchboard into various equipment were disconnected and reconnected to generators; while we demolished the existing board, and removed board bust duct along with cable and existing conduit. After removing the old switchboard it was replaced along with new cable trays and conductors.



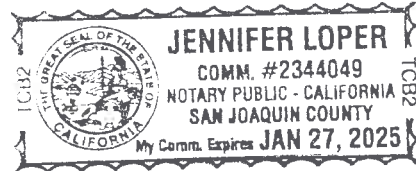
